The Leaf light is a table/desk lamp designed by Yves Behar, in collaboration with Herman Miller, Inc., that advances LED technology in every day consumer lighting. Leaf incorporates multiple new technology and design patents, including a microprocessor and finger touch controls that allow the user to adjust and blend a range of color (warm yellow to cool white) and light intensity, to respond to task or mood. Through Leaf's form and the microprocessor controls, it introduces a patented heat-distribution system that allows the LED chips to be cooled without incorporating a mechanical fan, a first for LED table lights. Leaf's 20 LEDs (10 yellow-white, 10 blue-white) consume less than 9 watts of power and have a lifespan of over 60,000 hours. Leaf has been accessioned into the design collection of the New York Museum of Modern Art and has received a CES 2007 "Best of Innovations" award for design and engineering.
